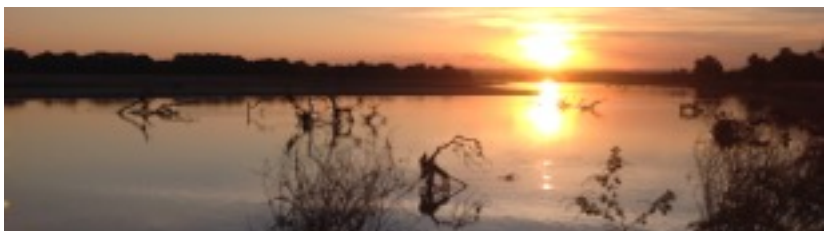

## **Air Arrangements/**

### **Arrivals**

Please let me know your air arrangements, so that we can ensure a representative from Habitat Zambia is there to pick you up on arrival.

**Some of you arriving in small groups (1-4 people) may need to take a taxi from the airport- B&B- this will be arranged for you- the driver will have a sign.**

You will need to pay the driver in cash (US\$), and I will reimburse you when you get to the B&B- please ensure you get a receipt. Fare- usually about \$50

## **Zambian Visas**

You need to apply for a VOLUNTEER Visa prior to leaving home- this must be applied for at least 30 days prior to entry. The Visa is good for 6 months.
